At the end of the Orientation Presentation, you will be asked to fill out an Orientation Questionnaire. The questionnaire contains 20 questions. A favorable score of 15 or more correct answers ensures that you are ready to start the journey of building a life from the inside out. Upon completion, click the submit button. Once we receive the questionnaire and all other required documents we will get you officially started as a Light Keeper within our organization.

We take Volunteerism seriously. We are serving women who are healing from life's challenges, therefore, we want to ensure that our Light Keepers are well-informed and ready to serve without judgment.

History

The Light of Truth Center, Inc. (LTC) founded in 1999, is a non-profit organization, which embraces a new, innovative three-phase process: recovery, transition, and restoration, all leading to transformation.

Light of Truth Center was created to assist women recovering from substance use to remain abstinent in a safe, clean, and caring environment. LTC's program is a three-phase recovery process. Recovery, transition, and restoration make up the essential elements for success, within our program, leading to restoration.

The Recovery Process includes securing safe housing, and a sponsor, working the steps associated with 12-step programs, and self-discovery.

<u>Transition</u> is developing the necessary life skills and spiritual tools to transition from a structured environment to self-sufficiency.

Restoration involves partnering with the necessary agency to restore residents to the community as viable, productive members of society, leading to complete transformation.

The LTC recognized a gap in the provision of services and supports to women in recovery, particularly as it relates to safe and secure housing. LTC is one of a few organizations in Baltimore that will support a woman's recovery process without regard to her ability to pay on a case-by-case base.

To continue to provide such support, Vaile Leonard, Founder, and CEO of the LTC realized that the organization needed to start doing things differently. LTC committed to a core set of beliefs and engaged in a strategic planning process that resulted in a clear strategy for growing the organization.



After 19 years of providing innovative services and support to the women who have entered its doors, largely through the commitment and service of a steady cadre of volunteers, the LTC was poised for phenomenal growth.

As such, in 2010, LTC acquired a 4,032-square-foot building through a partnership with Neighborhood Housing Services.

In 2019 LTC renovated two houses and a training center.

The development and renovation of the additional buildings will more than double the number of women the LTC will be able to support.

Mission

Mission Statement

The Light of Truth Center, Inc. is a non-profit organization dedicated to providing safe and supportive housing in an environment conducive to recovery, transition, and restoration for women recovering from addictions. The Light of Truth Center facilitates education, empowerment, enlightenment, and healing for the women it serves

VISION

The Light of Truth Center, Inc. is a thought-leader and innovator in women's addiction recovery. Serving as a model for cities nationwide, the Center's progressive philosophy and programs surround women in recovery with the real-world support they need to recover fully and permanently. That is to rediscover their true selves and become all that they were meant to be. The Center is continually researching, designing and testing forward-thinking concepts that not only help residents to heal, but also work to end the cycle of addiction by focusing on the whole woman – her family, her work, and her community. The Center advocates for the women it serves through grassroots and national initiatives that educate, empower, and evolve the women themselves, policy makers and society as a whole. Above all, the Light of Truth Center is committed to re-defining the standard of care given to recovering women by promoting non-traditional alternatives that create positive perceptions and attitudes, as well as profound change – from the inside out.

Core Beliefs

Women are truly in need of support and in need of a safe environment in which to recover and experience safety. As an organization we have established a set of core beliefs and values that we stand on and base all of our major decision and policies upon.

The Light of Truth Center:

- 1. Believes recovery is possible and everyone has the right to recover regardless of her ability to pay the initial fees.
- 2. Believes all souls can heal.
- 3. Stands on integrity and does everything in a spirit of genuine love and compassion.
- 4. Holds the vision of what's possible for a woman until see can see it for herself.
- 5. Serves the needs of women in a holistic manner and provides a safe space for the recovery of the physical, mental and spiritual aspects of a woman.

Core Beliefs

The Light of Truth Center:

- 6. Honors the dignity and esteem of all women.
- 7. Gives women the choice and opportunity for a new way of life.
- 8. Loves woman until they can learn to love themselves.
- 9. Believes women are people and not statistics.
- 10. Believes all women possess positive life skills that unfold through recovery, transition and restoration.

Application Process

- All Light Keepers will be asked to complete an orientation process and complete a volunteer application. Each applicant will be asked to provide contact information and your work history
- In addition, Light Keepers will be asked to identify areas of interest
- ► Each Light Keeper will be given a volunteer manual once the orientation is complete
- After completing the volunteer quiz, providing all required paperwork and documents, Light Keepers will receive a certificate of completion
